Pearson BTEC Level 2 First Certificate in Music.

Is this course for me?

If you want to learn more about the Music Industry then this course is for you. You will take a role in producing a musical product, learn recording techniques, learn about how musicians work and explore different roles within the Music Industry.

What does the course involve?

Two exams:

The Music Industry - Understand different types of organisations and job roles that make up the Music Industry.

Music and Production Analysis – Understand how to listen critically to a variety of popular music

Five specialist units:

Introducing Live Sound, Introducing Recording, Introducing Theory, Managing a Music Product, Producing a Music Recording

These units are internally assessed through portfolio evidence. They are intended to give an introduction to different roles within the Music Industry.

How will my work be assessed?

Two units have a 1-hour written exam (25%). The other units are assessed internally by portfolio evidence (75%). Portfolio evidence includes audio recording, video recording, written evidence, log sheets for example.
