	block release. Over the 3 years of the Service Technician Apprenticeship, you will be required to

	1 <sup>st</sup> Year – You will have 6 weeks of training
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Year – You will have 7 weeks of training
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Year – You will have 4 weeks of training
