The Nature of God



• Omnipotent - means God (Allah) can do anything.

• Beneficent - doing good, being generous and kind.

• Merciful - forgiving when people do wrong.

• Transcendent - Allah is beyond human understanding. Allah is unknowable.

• Immanence - Allah is close to humanity and involved in the world.

• Monotheism - belief in one God.

• Fairness - part of Allah's nature - treats humans equally and as they deserve.

• Masque - the Muslim place of worship.
